Discussion was held on the publication of Ordinances in the official newspapers and the verification of timely publishing. State Statutes require a minimum of 20 days between last date of publication and Adoption of the Ordinances. It was determined that the earliest possible special meeting to adopt ordinances would be October 29, 2020.

Wiseman updated the Board on the superintendent's contract being prepared by the District's attorney.

Utech updated the Board on the transfer of assets agreement with Hughes County, as being prepared by the District's attorney. The proposed completion date is set for November 1.

Wiseman presented the short-year 2020 Budget for approval. He noted that he used prior history of operations from by Hughes County to create the budget and added known start-up expenses. Wiseman presented the 2021 Budget for review, stating he would ask of approval at the next meeting.

Utech opened the floor to public comment. Discussion was made on the proposed billing process with credit card payments and if the District had a plan to upgrade meters.
