

The Spring Creek Cow Creek Sanitary District (SCCCSD) recognizes the outstanding cooperation that the South Dakota Game Fish and Parks has provided to benefit the Spring Creek/Cow Creek areas.

Specifically, during the planning and site development phase of the new water tower, SCCCSD encountered difficulties due to artifacts found within the proposed tower location. This had the potential of skyrocketing costs to the residents of SCCCSD in order to either purchase additional land or to move the site altogether. Two alternative sites were proposed with additional construction costs well-exceeding \$575,000 dollars each. South Dakota Game Fish and Parks staff offered their expertise and knowledge to facilitate a new location near the original proposed site. South Dakota Game Fish and Parks additionally provided the District with a long-term lease for the area currently under construction. South Dakota Game Fish and Parks Staff contributed numerous work hours to facilitate the ease of environmental and cultural clearances, which resulted in significant cost savings.

The SCCCSD Board of Trustees would like to formally thank the South Dakota Game Fish and Parks, specifically Pat Buscher, Central SD Regional Park Supervisor, for going above and beyond to provide us outstanding and highly valuable assistance. To say that we are grateful is an understatement.
